### **How the Bible (not Bethany) says Grace**

- Grace used 156x in NT...
- Luke 1:30-31: Grace the source of Mary's favor... (cf. 1Cor.15:10)
- Gal.1:3, 6:18: NT letters open and close with grace...
- Rev.22:21: Last lines of NT is grace...
- Exod.34:6: OT overtones of grace...

### **Defining Grace**

- Grace: "unmerited favor"
- "Grace: a gift that costs everything for the giver and nothing for the recipient." -Philip Yancey
- A verse to define grace: Eph.2:8-10
- Wesleyan Understanding of Grace:
  - 1) \_\_\_\_\_ Grace (Mt.5:44-45) 2) \_\_\_\_ Grace (Rom.3:24-25)
  - 3) \_\_\_\_\_ Grace (2Pet.3:18)
- The House of Grace...
