**Intro:** Last week, Acts 15 and how to handle conflict: church conflict and personal conflict.

**Read:** Acts 15:36-16:40

**15:36-41**—Mission agreed upon…issue was with Mark…

**v.1**—Same city of lame man's healing (ch.14).

v.1b-3—Timothy's background...

- Circumcision unnecessary in Jerusalem Council decision (cf. ch.15)...
- Timothy circumcised not for salvation but for mission w/ people in mixed audiences...

**v.4-5**—Growing faith, growing numbers...

**v.6-10**—Two closed doors until the Macedonia mission opens...

v.11-12—Philippi, key city in Macedonia...

- The "we" seems to include Luke (v.10).
- **v.13-15**—Lydia's business and affluence ("purple goods" and "house")...

v.16-24—Exploited slave girl...

- Healing that turns into beating/arresting...
- **v.25-34**—Singing/praying in prison and a soldiers conversion...
- v.35-40—Released with dignity...

## **Discerning God's Leading**

- 1) The S\_\_\_\_\_\_ (v.6-7, Jn.16:13)
  Part of the Spirit's work is as personal guide...
  2) S\_\_\_\_\_\_ Disciplines (v.25, 10, 13:2-3, 5)
  - Receptors to receive the Spirit's signals: prayer, God's Word, fasting, Sabbath, solitude, service, Christian conferencing...
- 3) S\_\_\_\_\_ in Life (v.6-10)
  - What's God opening/closing in front of us?
- 4) S\_\_\_\_\_ of S\_\_\_\_ (15:36, 16:10, 40)
  - Paul's not making decisions alone...
- 5) S\_\_\_\_\_(v.9-10)
  - God's special revelation to people...



Read: Galatians 5-6

\*From this passage, what do you notice about how Christians are to live?

\*What spoke to you this past Sunday (ie. what made you laugh, learn, look deeper at life etc.)?

\*Thru a variety of circumstances, Paul sensed God's guidance in this journey (15:6-10). Has there been a time in your life you've clearly sensed God's leading in a certain direction? How did you know it was God's leading?

\*Paul had two failed journey's before Philippi opened up for him. Have you ever had any failed paths that later led to the right path? Explain.

\*Lots happened in Philippi (Lydia's conversion, slave girls deliverance, arresting, beating, jailing, earthquaking, etc.). Which story most captured your attention? Why?

\*Why did God lead Paul to Macedonia if it included beatings and imprisonings?
