Lasting Lessons from Paul's Life

- Gospel spread numerically and geographically (cf. Acts 1:8, 28:31)...
- Spread thru long days and lots of loving labor (cf. 2Cor.11:26-27)...

Riots, physical pain, relational strife...all realities Paul had to represent Jesus thru!

Paul's way with all sorts of people

(kings/commoners) in all sorts of places (synagogues/markets/courts/homes)...

- Ways God shapes His saints...
- Prayer, God's Word, worship, solitude, Christian friends, all a part of Paul's life!

5) Special revelations in special times of need (27:23-24, 23:11, 16:9-10, 18:9-11, 9:3-4)...

- Paul sought out church and served the church the duration of his Christian life...
 - Your past does not DQ you from having a future with God!!!
