Intro: Studying Judges since mid-August...

- Judges: life in dysfunctional days!
- Shifting gears from leaders (Deborah, Gideon, Jephthah, Samson, etc.) to society...

17:1—Ephraim, a key tribe in Israel... v.2—The breakdown of the family is the

breakdown of the community...
Son stealing from mom and her blessing?!!
v.3-5—Would the God who said "don't make idols" be honored by this idol (cf. v.13)?!!

v.6—Repeat storyline...when "truth" turns to personal opinion/actions...

v.7-8—The role of Levites in OT...

- v.9-13—Micah hires the Levite for idolatry...
  - Despite the "God" language (v.13), this is NOT God's design...

**18:1**—Danites discontented with land allotted... **v.2-6**—Overhearing a familiar voice and being told what we want to hear (v.6)...

**v.7-10**—Waring against a peaceful people group and claiming this is what God wants?!!

• Danger in putting words in God's mouth! v.11-17—Stealing and looting Micah's house before stealing and looting Laish...

• Small crimes leading to bigger crimes... v.18-20—From questioning to helping in heist. v.21-26—The one who stole from his mom gets stolen from and can do nothing to stop it. v.27-31—Society gone wrong on so many levels even among God's people!

• Tribe of Dan's negative legacy in the rest of the OT/NT (cf. Rev.7:4-8)...
