- 4) Pick an Essay: What is the most over the top birth announcement you've ever seen for a kid? Why do you think God chose a star to signal His Son's birth? OR Think of someone who is difficult to be around. What makes them hard to be around? (2:1-3)
- 5) What's a gift you have been super excited to give? Why do you think the wise men gave these gifts? (2:11)
- 6) What characteristics/choices impresses you most about Joseph—the man God chose to be the adoptive father of His Son?

## 4th Sunday of Advent



<u>Leader</u>: "I am the **true** vine, and my Father is the gardener. (15:1)

<u>Congregation</u>: "When the Advocate comes, whom I will send to you from the Father—the Spirit of **truth** who goes out from the Father—he will testify about me. (15:26)

<u>Leader</u>: But when he, the Spirit of **truth**, comes, he will guide you into all the **truth**. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come. (16:13)

Congregation: Now this is eternal life: that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent. (17:3)

<u>Leader</u>: Sanctify them by the **truth**; your word is **truth**. (17:17)
