1)

- Remember the time period (1:1), yet Ruth/Boaz are not a product of their era!
- The Chosen fish scene at credits...swimming upstream.
- To be "in" but not "of" the world (Jn.17:14-15, Rom.12:1-2)...

- "Guardian-redeemer" and "redeem" used 22x in just 4 chapters of Ruth!
- Road to Redemption in Ruth: pain, loyalty/faithfulness/endurance, hard work, and a Redeemer...
