A Doctor's Diagnosis of Jesus: Pediatrics


Luke 2:21-52

Intro: Dr. Luke's data moves from OB/GYN stories of Jesus' beginnings into Pediatrics...

- **v.21**—Circumcision as sign in OT of raising a child in the faith (Gen.17).
- **v.22-24**—Two parents trying to live out faithfully what they find in God's Word...
- Mary and Joseph of meager means...God choosing not because of finances but faith!
- v.25—How do people describe you?
- v.26-33—Normal baby experience? NO!!!
 - Simeon more excited about Jesus' birth than even Mary and Joseph ☺
- v.34-35—This baby's legacy isn't all cute...
- v.36-38—Anna's endurance of hard
- knocks...ran to God rather than from God!
- **v.39-40**—Summary statements...growth physically, mentally, and spiritually.
- v.41—Another tradition around faith...
- **v.42-44**—Parental mistakes happen...retrace steps when necessary!
- Parental boundaries...
- v.45-46—The posture of this 12-year-old...
- **v.47-49**—"my Father's house..."
- v.50-52—Summary statement includes social growth...
